

New Quarterly Invoicing System

To help streamline our processes and make things simpler for everyone, the Chamber is moving from monthly invoicing to quarterly invoicing.

What does this mean for you?

Chamber members will still only receive one invoice per year—the timing will simply align with our new quarterly schedule. As always, you will have 90 days to pay your invoice, just as in the past.

Here are the new invoicing dates:

- Q1: January 1 – March 31 → Invoice issued early January
- Q2: April 1 – June 30 → Invoice issued early April
- Q3: July 1 – September 30 → Invoice issued early July
- Q4: October 1 – December 31 → Invoice issued early October

We will begin invoicing quarterly on October 1st, 2025. All members with renewals due between October 1st and December 31st will receive their invoice then, with a due date of December 31st.

For example: *gloves being made, coffee beans being roasted, permanent jewelry being crafted, or other behind-the-scenes moments that show what makes your business special.*

If you already have photos or videos you'd like us to consider, please share them with the Chamber. If not, but you would like your business or nonprofit featured, contact us—we'll be happy to schedule a time to capture photos or videos on your behalf.


- **Join an Event Planning Committee**
